GDCA WESTERN DIVISION MEETING APRIL 2, 2011 SILVER STATE KC GROUNDS, LAS VEGAS, NV

In the absence of the Western Division Chairman, Putt Richards, the meeting was called to order by Cindy Harwin, Division Show Chair, at 10:45 a.m. Cindy was reluctant to start the meeting without Putt, however because of the heat, many of those present were reluctant to leave their dogs out and were anxious to return to their air conditioned homes or hotel rooms.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

GROUNDS – Mike Boa reported that conformation judging will take place in the ballroom, and that only the Parent Club table and the GDCA Rescue booth will be able to be accommodated inside the ballroom. Vendor space will be located at various sites on the grounds. Golf carts can be rented at \$235/week, with a 1 week minimum required. The rings and grounds will be set up on Friday, October 28th. Volunteers from each Club are needed to help with set up, and also with tearing down on Saturday, November 5th. Mike again requested that the GDCC bring their trailer and ring equipment.

Cathy Schaefer said that had been agreed on at a previous GDCC meeting. Kathy Munyan also volunteered EZ ups from the GDCAZ for the outdoor Performance Events.

RV PARKING – John Garcia reminded everyone that we have a limit of 50 spaces only, and that 33 have already been reserved. He is looking into the possibility of a nearby lot for overflow RV parking, but this site would have no hookups. John asked that Cindy or Putt get back to him ASAP regarding the timeline for his committee, stating that he has to know exactly when the parking lot will be available for him to begin marking spaces for our incoming RVs.

TOP TWENTY – Linda Tonnancour is still waiting for the newly updated rules and regs for the Top Twenty. She asked Cindy to remind the GDCA BOD to send them to her per her previous request.

HOSPITALITY – Judy Martin inquired as to where the hospitality room would be located, and a discussion was held about the location and what refreshments will be available. At this time, we are considering splitting a large room near the conformation judging ring, and having some crating in $\frac{1}{2}$ of the space and the Raffle Room and Hospitality in the other half. If this is the case, it will be necessary to buy our supplies from the hotel, but the money spent will apply to our food budget requirement, per Cindy.

RESERVATIONS – Lora Thill reminded everyone present that the Wigwam is presently booked to capacity, but that each year rooms open up after the September 1st deadline, so get on the waiting list now if you want to be contacted by the Wigwam to fill any vacancies that may come up. There are also 4 overflow hotels listed on our website, and the cost is comparable to the Wigwam.

CATALOG – Jennifer Costantinidis had several innovative ideas for drawing in catalog ads. She reminded everyone to get ads in as soon as possible.

MEETING ROOMS – Lucretia Marcus said she has only received a couple of requests for meeting rooms at this time, and inquired as to number of rooms and locations that will be available to her to assign.

She also asked who would be financially responsible for any refreshments needed by those booking the rooms. Lucretia will check with Putt and Susan, for a definitive answer on this. In the past, each committee was responsible for whatever refreshments they ordered.

PREMIUM LIST – Cindy Harwin will coordinate the GDCA National Premium List with the Great Dane Club of Tucson Premium List.

Mike Boa is to send Cindy the necessary Evacuation Plan, to be included in our program.

HEALTH CLINIC – Linda Jacobs said that they are prepared to present a Cardio Clinic as well as an Eye Clinic, but that the requirement from the vet for the eye clinic was a minimum of 50 dogs. A discussion was held and most felt that that minimum might be hard to meet. Linda will check on this and get back to Putt and Cindy with the results.

WELCOME PARTY – Jamie Harshfield was not present with a report.
