Changes to the AKC's Canine Good Citizen Program (CGC)

Started in 1989, the Canine Good Citizen Program is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The Canine Good Citizen Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. Prior to January 1, 2013, all dogs who passed the 10-step CGC test may receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club.

However, starting on January 1, 2013 all dogs who pass the Canine Good Citizen (CGC) test will receive a title following their name.

As we do each year, we will offer CGC testing on April 27, 2013 following the obedience and rally events at our Specialty Show. In order to help you prepare for CGC testing, we will offer a CGC seminar following our club meeting on January 12, 2013. At this meeting we will provide a demo of a CGC test, CGC participant training booklets, an 8 week training curriculum for you and your dog and answer any training questions you might have about preparing for the CGC test.

A few facts to know:

- If your dog earned a CGC certificate prior to January 1, 2013, you may convert this certificate into a title for your animal.
- The GDCA offers a Versatile Great Dane Award for any Dane that has earned a Conformation title as well as two other AKC awarded titles. The Versatile Dane designation may be awarded to any dane living or dead.
