Mandated by the GDCA National Specialty Rules & Regulations "The Board of Directors also confirms that financial arrangements will be that all profits remain in the Division will be distributed to the Divisions' Clubs in accordance with their contributions. The GDA and the Hosting Division's will share losses equally. All clubs in the Hosting Division will share equally in the Division's portion of any losses."

As in prior National Specialties, a percentage of the profits (to be determined after financial reconciliation of the current event) will be set aside & invested for future Western Division Nationals. Additionally, a percentage of the profits (also to be determined after financial reconciliation of the current event) will be donated to a Great Dane related charty.

Western Division Requirements:

- 2. At least \$100 donation to the Trophy Fund
- 3. At least a \$25 dontation to the Hospitality Room
- 4. One item to the Welcome Bag
- 5. Each Club must supply workers for the various committees requiring manpower during the week long event.
- 6. One or more auction donations
- 7. One or more raffle donations, including a gift basket highlightinh interests and/or local of your club
- 8. Each club to designate an onsite coordinator as the point of contact at the event.
