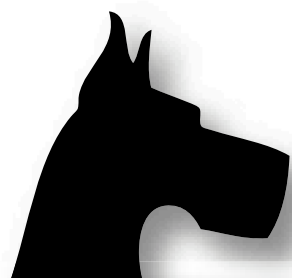

The Paxton's sure started off the New Year with a BANG !!!

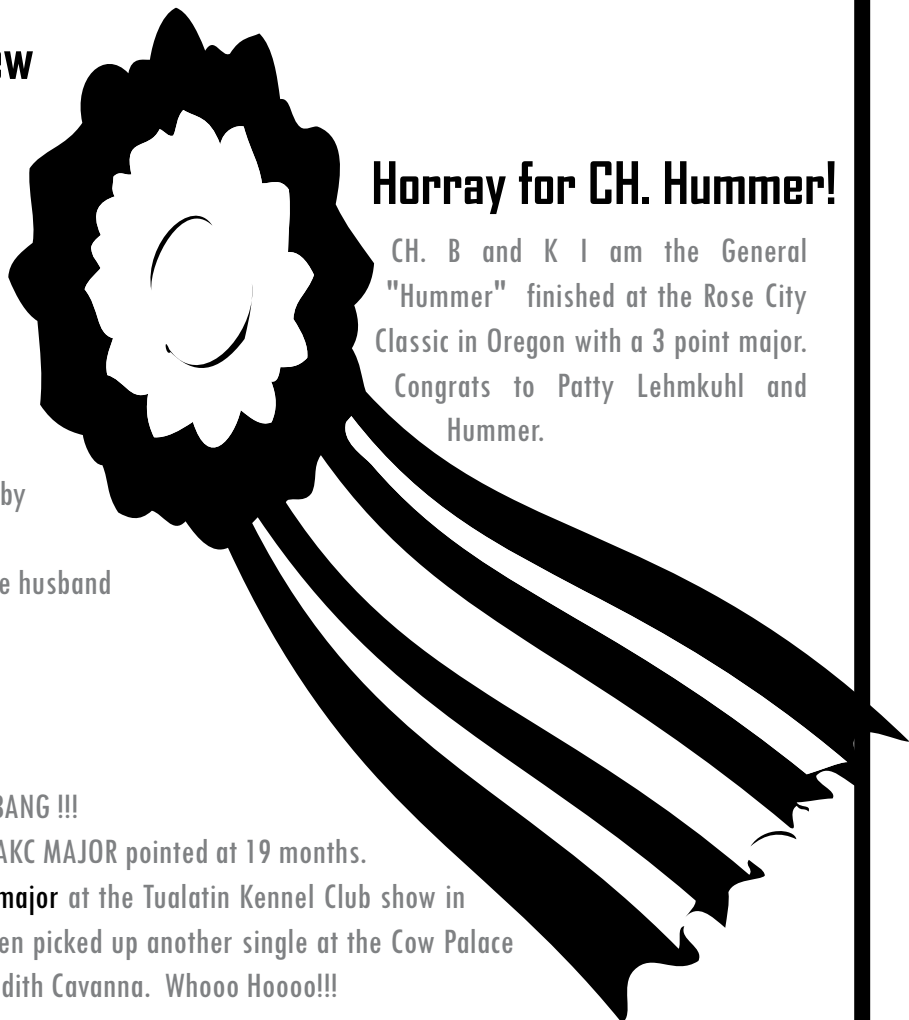
Kissinger, Int Ch Equiss Kiss N Mr Big Stuff, is now AKC MAJOR pointed at 19 months.
