The 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition is open to all Great Dane puppies that are (4) months & under (6) six months of age on the day of the event. The class is not divided by sex, and there will be a selection of Best of Breed Beginner Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex to Beginner Puppy. The 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competitions will begin immediately before the afternoon show on Saturday and Monday.

- An AKC registration number or litter number will be required for entries.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- No puppy can be judged if it is bandaged, taped, glued, stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs will be excused from judging, but, at judge's discretion, may return to the ring to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.
- Professional Handlers are not allowed to exhibit in this competition. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition.

## BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. Winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

## NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

These events qualify for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS). Exhibitor must check the owner-handled eligible checkbox on the entry form to be eligible. ## NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

(Sunday AM Only)

**Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and at least two but no more than four of their Get. Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Entry fee is \$27 for the unit.

**Brood Bitch Class** - The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, and Produce for Get.

**Brace Class** - Two Great Danes that must have at least one common owner, and to be presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of entry. Dogs do not need to be entered in another conformation class. A dog may only be entered in one brace. Spayed/neutered allowed. Mark "Brace Class" in the space provided for Additional Classes. Entry fee is \$27 for the unit.

**Team Class** - Four Great Danes that must have at least one common owner, and to be presented by a maximum of four handlers. The dogs comprising the Team **MUST** be named at time of entry. Dogs do not need to be entered in another conformation class. A dog may only be entered in one team. Spayed/neutered allowed. Mark "Team Class" in the space provided for Additional Classes. Entry fee is \$27 for the unit.

**AWARDS OF MERIT:** After selecting Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch, the judge may present Awards of Merit, at his/her discretion to any exhibit competing in Best of Breed. The number of awards to be offered may be up to two (2) of the dogs entered in Best of Breed.

**BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES:** To be chosen from the winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 Puppy classes. The winner of the Bred-by-Exhibitor puppy class is *not* eligible to compete for Best Puppy.

- TELEPHONE, CONDITIONAL AND UNSIGNED entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Fees must accompany entries.
- POSTDATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check.
- PLEASE TYPE or NEATLY PRINT all entries. Use black or blue ink.
- CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received prior to close of entries. Changes are not acceptable by telephone. Email or faxed changes are allowed.
- ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS: Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
- FIRST ENTRY OF EACH DOG IN CONFORMATION OR OBEDIENCE includes an AKC Recording Fee of \$.50. In addition, each entry of a dog in single-entry recording classes includes \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. These fees are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Event or Tracking Test and are collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these fees are collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Each first rally entry of a dog (per event) includes a \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee and each additional rally entry includes \$3.00 AKC fee.
- ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event's Show Committee. If, because of riots, wars, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The wellbeing of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, if it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

(American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sec 6)
- DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

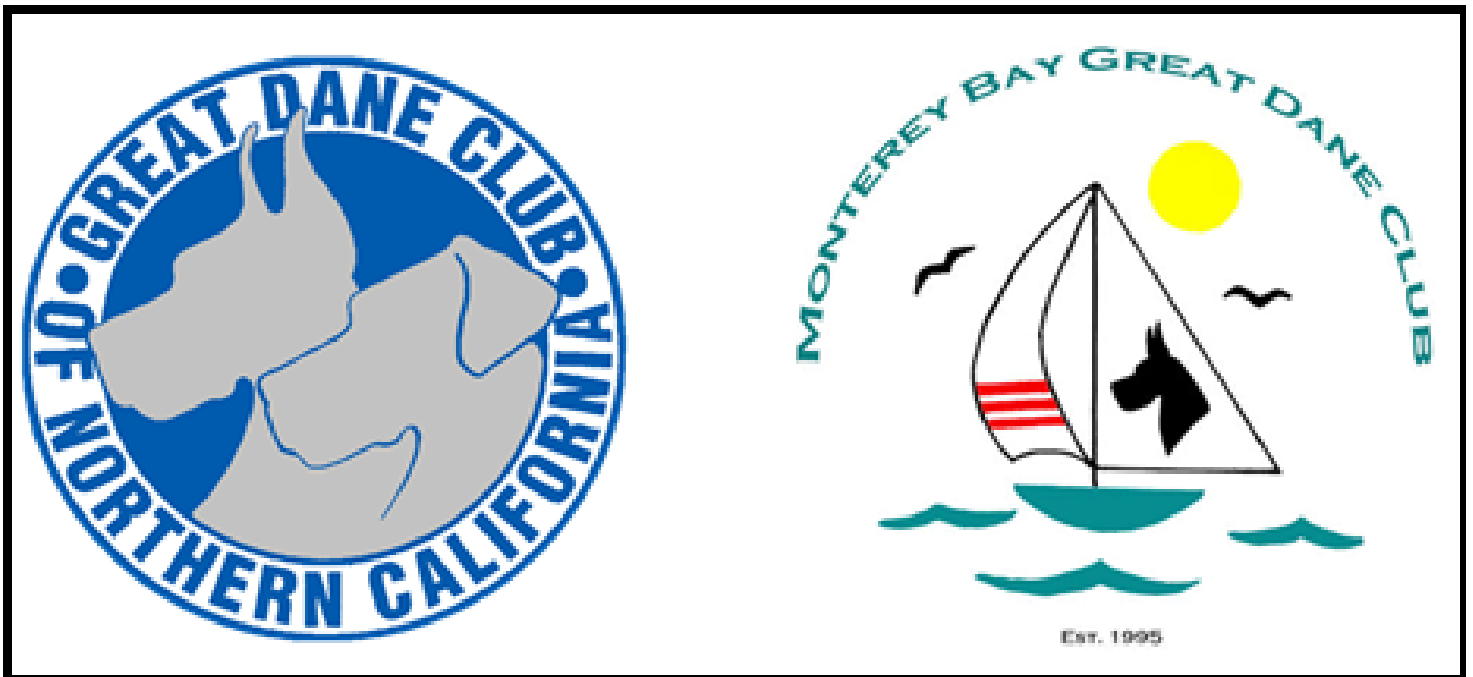
